The annual growth of exports directly reflects the quality of Lithuanian products appreciated by consumers. The continuous creation of new products also contributes to expansions into foreign and local markets. The traditional exhibition "Made in Lithuania" is one of the places for their introduction to markets.

Lithuania is a dynamic and open country that leads the Baltic region in innovation and puts a great focus on supporting and developing talents. Lithuania is among top 20 countries most favourable for business according to the World Bank's study Doing Business 2018 that assessed the business environment in 190 countries.

In recent years, the Lithuanian manufacturing sector has maintained a stable growth. It is stimulated by investments of international companies in Lithuania. During 2010–2017, 100 foreign-owned manufacturers established or expanded their business in Lithuania.

Manufacturing sector structure

- 19% of the Lithuanian GDP is created in the manufacturing sector
- ~12 foreign-owned manufacturing projects per year
