

Merchants experience change in the past and present



- Historically, a merchant is a person or company who is involved in wholesale trade, especially one dealing with foreign countries or supplying goods to a particular trade
- In 16th century Europe two different terms for merchants emerged: meerseniers referred to local traders and koopman (Dutch: koopman) referred to merchants who operated on a global stage and offering added-value services such as credit and finance



 21st century presents locally or globally and mostly online acting merchants in a need of added value services that can be reached digitally





Silk Road Merchants

The Silk Road was a network of trade routes which connected the East and West from the 2nd century BCE to the 18th century.

Though silk was the major trade item exported from China, many other goods and ideas were exchanged.

Diseases, most notably plague, also spread along the Silk Road.
